Re: HB 2282

Dear Rep. Aguilar:

The Professional Certification Coalition (PCC)¹ writes to share our views regarding HB 2282. In its current form, HB 2282 would create an unwarranted exception to licensure standards on which the public relies. While the PCC's preference is to work with bill sponsors on amendments where we identify areas of disagreements, these aspects of the bill are core to the legislation. **The PCC accordingly must oppose HB 2282**; we explain the basis for our concerns below.

The PCC recognizes that not all occupations may require formal higher education for an individual to gain the necessary expertise to practice that occupation, and the PCC supports the development and recognition of apprenticeship programs as alternative pathways to entry into some regulated occupations. The PCC's concern about HB 2282, however, is that it treats all regulated professions in the same way. Title 32 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, which the bill would amend, governs licensing requirements for occupations as varied as physicians, cosmetologists, professional engineers, real estate agents, and dentists. The bill does not distinguish between these occupations, but provides that, notwithstanding any other law, each regulating authority in Title 32 "shall establish criteria for granting licenses ... through apprenticeship programs."

Determining whether an alternative pathway is appropriate requires the balancing the need to protect the public and the interests of lowering costs, promoting market competition, and reducing barriers to entry to an occupation, by reviewing the specific requirements for earning a license, certificate, or registration in each profession. However, as currently drafted, HB 2282 mandates all occupations – from barbers to CPAs to radiologists – to establish a pathway to bypass current requirements through an apprenticeship program.

For these reasons, the PCC opposes HB 2282 in its current form and will be urging the committee of jurisdiction to refrain from advancing this legislation. The PCC would not oppose



an amended version of the bill that proposes apprenticeship pathways to licensure only for specific occupations that already have approved apprenticeship programs in place, but the Arizona legislature is better positioned than the PCC to identify those occupations.

The PCC stands ready to work with lawmakers who seek to craft legislation that strikes a reasonable balance between the benefits of occupational regulation and the desire for free markets in employment. Unfortunately, in its current form, this legislation goes too far in removing protections for the public.
